BUNYA MOUNTAINS / RAINBOW BEACH

An Aboriginal meeting place for various tribes, Bullock and Horse teams, The Bunya Nut and The Bunya Pine are all associated with the mystical Bunya Mountains. Rainforest-clad peaks rising 500m above the plains shelter the world's largest stand of ancient Bunya Pines, and you will marvel at these dome shaped pines. Brilliantly coloured king parrots, crimson rosellas and satin bowerbirds are also common sights. We shall also have the opportunity to visit some of the area's other attractions during our three night stay, before we continue onto Rainbow Beach for our remaining two nights.
